



AVID (Advancement via Individual Determination) is a college-preparation system. It is offered as an elective class to students who would like to prepare for entrance into a four-year college or university. The AVID class is designed to help students acquire the skills and behaviors they will need to do well and gain acceptance to a four-year college or university. Students are taught study skills, note taking, time management, organization, reading, writing, collaboration, and research skills, while learning about college and career options for the future. AVID students learn both in the classroom as well as outside of classroom through field trips to colleges, universities, or other cultural sites. The elective class also includes time for tutorial groups, where students receive help with material from their academic classes. AVID recruits students who are motivated to do well and willing to work hard to make success a reality, now and in the future. AVID students are expected to maintain a 75% or better in all courses. If this sounds like the right class for your student, please encourage and support them in applying to AVID.
