



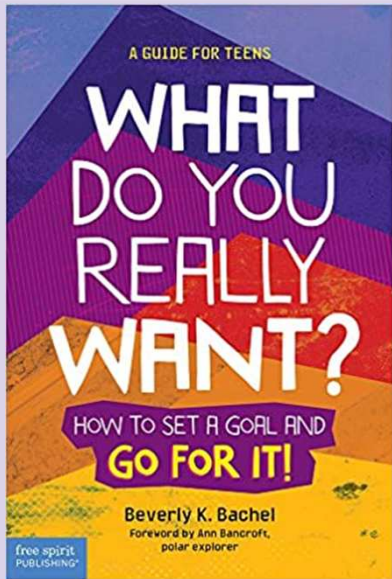

Secondary Summer Reading Goals

- ❖ Every student that will be entering 6-12 grades for the 2021-2022 school year will be required to read during the 2021 summer; summer reading is not required for advanced students only.
- ❖ Provide each student with book(s) purchased by the district.
- ❖ All students will read an informational text novel to provide independent summer practice and guided assistance in summer school for this statewide/nationwide genre that is an area of needed improvement for most students.
- ❖ Advanced students will be challenged to read texts with higher Lexile levels to prepare students for postsecondary readiness Lexile demands.
- ❖ All students will utilize the goal book to assist with academic and pacing goals with the Learning Management System- Edgenuity Courseware.
- ❖ All students use reading to synthesize information for ELAR and all other academic areas in conjunction with the Marshall Community-Community Read.
- ❖ All students will increase their reading volume and stamina.

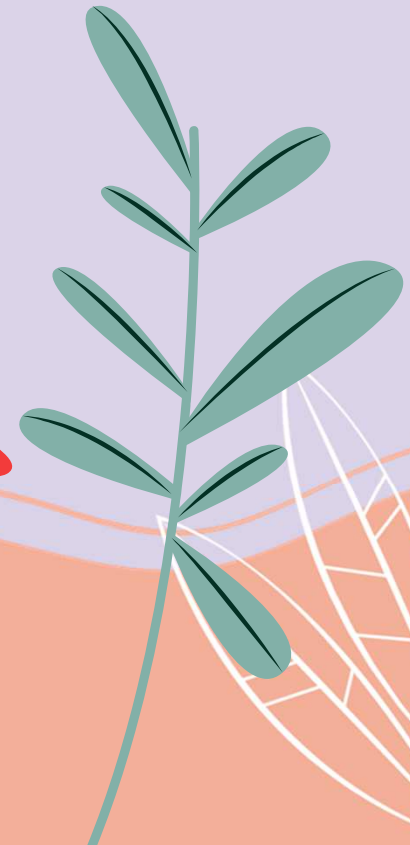




- ❖ Required Summer Reading novel for **all** incoming 6-12 grade students.
- ❖ Community read with five different virtual discussions from various community members (five parts to the book)
- ❖ Goal setting skills will be done during the foundational literacy skills/correspondence unit during the first six weeks of 2021-2022 school year. Students will visit these goals frequently throughout the school year.

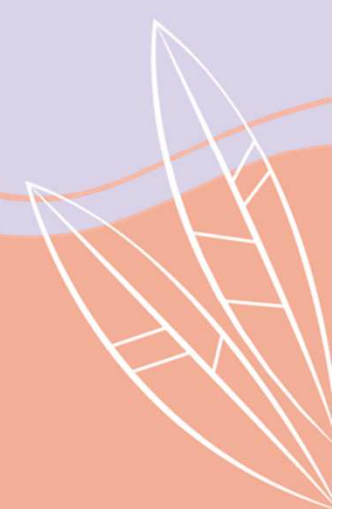

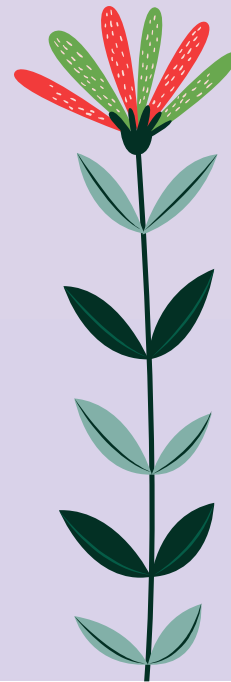
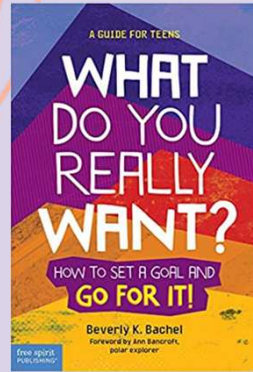

- ❖ **MJHS Advanced ELAR - 2 additional novels**
- ❖ **MHS PreAP ELAR - 2 additional novels**
- ❖ **MHS AP ELAR - 3 additional novels**

Advanced ELAR teachers will choose the novels for their students and create the summer activities for the novels. MJHS STEM teachers will create a PBL for the book chosen.

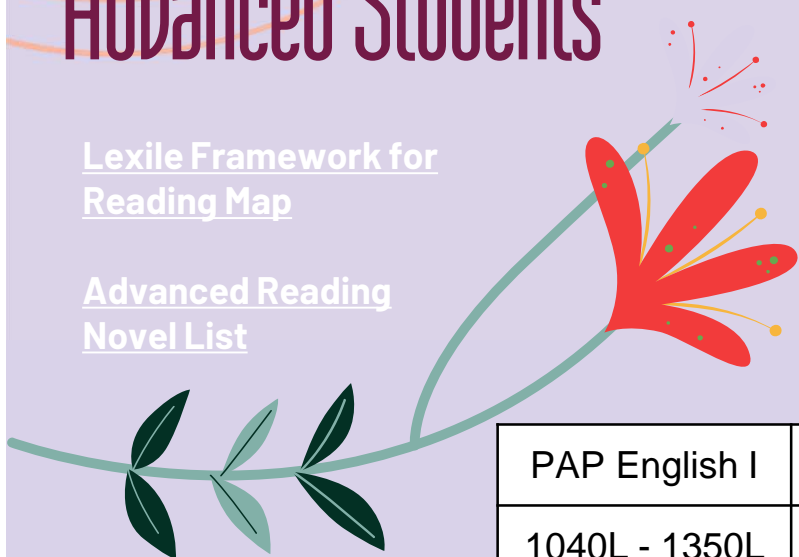

- ❖ There will be no summer reading exams; the summer reading activities will be graded and count during the first six weeks of school.
